Total membership in APGO is now 68 including one Geoscientist-in-Training. Over 1700 application packages have been sent out with 350 applications for membership being received to date. Many more applications are expected to be received in the next one-two months. The Registration Committee has scheduled an expanded series of meetings over the summer to deal with the expected large volume of applications to come.

“It is very important that geoscientists in Ontario are aware that after August 30, 2002, the Professional Geoscientists Act, 2000 requires that an individual be a member of APGO in order to practice professional geoscience in Ontario.” says Dr. Greg Finn, P.Geo., Chair of the Registration Committee. “Geoscientists need to submit their applications as soon as possible to ensure that people can become registered by the in-force date proclaimed for the Act” Finn said. Finn went on to note that the deadline for applicants to be accepted as referees is June 30, 2002.
